

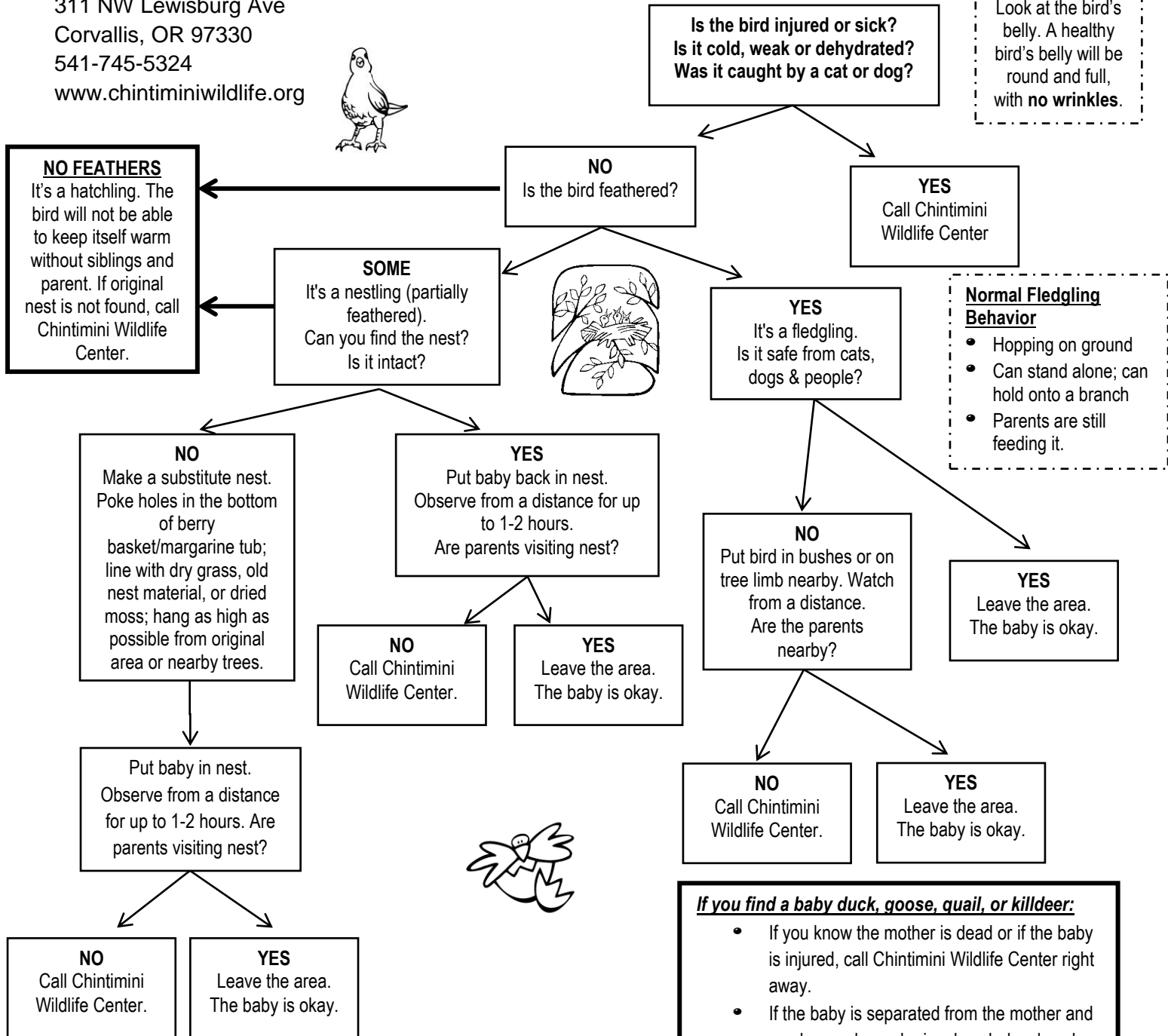
I Found a Baby Bird

How to Look for Dehydration

Look at the bird's belly. A healthy bird's belly will be round and full, with **no wrinkles**.



Normal Fledgling Behavior

- Hopping on ground
- Can stand alone; can hold onto a branch
- Parents are still feeding it.

If you find a baby duck, goose, quail, or killdeer:

- If you know the mother is dead or if the baby is injured, call Chintimini Wildlife Center right away.
- If the baby is separated from the mother and you know where she is, place baby close by so she can hear it. Watch from a distance.
- If the mother is not found or does not claim the baby within one hour, call Chintimini Wildlife Center.
